How to Understand Basic Guitar chord ? Three points in guitar playing that must be mastered at the start Learning acoustic guitar Is the chord, the movement between chords and taps. First you need to know the guitar key types. The guitar keys have a lot of variations. For beginners should only learn about Major Key and Minor Key. Do not study the others Focus on the points above In Learning acoustic guitar Some are practicing directly with the song and some are learning only with the chord alone. It is more difficult if you directly with the song because you have to memorize and know the key correctly while moving your finger on the fret of the guitar with a tap corresponding to the song. The most important thing here is that all the strings on your guitar are not false and all sounds normal.
