



What is a hanging chord on a guitar? The chord / hanging guitar is a chord, where we hit a point in the guitar fret, and that point is more than the basic chord. Hanging chords require 4 fingers in play. Hanging chords are used to produce a guitar sound that sounds more different from the base chord. Although in fact the basic chord can produce the same nuance with some point additions. In this hanging chord learning course you have mastered the basic chord of the guitar. When skipping the basic chord then it is difficult to proceed to the next step Hanging chords are an advanced stage of a basic chord or can be considered a modification of a basic chord, because there are some chords that are of the same nuance as the basic chord.
